"Fur & Feathers" A preschool class in the gardens! Thursdays June 28 - Aug. 2, 11 am to noon.

Designed for children ages 3 – 5, this year's class will focus on the relationship between common garden creatures and the plants they eat.

This class is literature-based, so expect classic children's books like "Peter Rabbit," by Beatix Potter and "Feathers for Lunch," by Lois Ehlert. Rabbits, groundhogs, chipmunks, and deer will populate the "furry" lessons. We are hoping for Purple Martins to move into our new gourd rack and be our "feathery" friends. New this year is a Children's Vegetable Garden that will enhance the hands-on aspect of the program. So bring a grown up and get your hands dirty as we plant some seeds! Class size is limited to 18 children with a head teacher, Heather Zimmerman, an assistant, and help from our grown-ups!

Cost for the 6-week term is \$20 for nonmembers, \$15 for members. Preregistration and prepayment is required to hold your child's spot in class.
